**MILESTONE ASSESSMENT 2 IN TERM 2 FOR SECONDARY 4 & 5**

With the removal of Mid-Year Examinations for the graduating cohort from 2023 onwards, Milestone Assessments are conducted in term 1 and term 2 to progressively assess key student competencies and application of core subject knowledge that culminate in students' synoptic understanding of the subject matter in the Preliminary Examination.

In accordance to MOE guidelines, the school has allocated the percentage of each term's assessment as shown in the table below. These weighted assessments count towards the final grade for each subject.

\*Preliminary examinations are conducted in Term 3 except for selected Mother Tongue Language 'O' Level Preliminary Examination that will be conducted in Term 2. Details of the examination will be shared separately.


