WEIGHTED ASSESSMENT 1 FOR SECONDARY 4 & 5

Weighted Assessments are conducted in Term 1 and Term 2 to progressively assess key student competencies and application of core subject knowledge that culminates in students' synoptic understanding of the subject matter in the Preliminary Examination.

Please be informed that Weighted Assessment 1 (WA 1) will be conducted in Term 1 Week 7, from 15 February 2024 (Thursday) to Term 1 Week 8, 23 February 2024 (Friday). Attached herewith is the Weighted Assessment 1 Timetable for your reference.

In accordance to MOE guidelines, the school has allocated the percentage of each term's assessment as shown in the table below. These weighted assessments count towards the final grade for each subject.

We would like to draw your attention to the following rules and regulations that govern all assessment matters:

- I. No make-up assessments will be conducted for students who are absent on the day of the Weighted Assessments.
- II. Students who are certified medically unfit to take the Weighted Assessments will be recorded as "absent with valid reason". They must submit the original copy of the Medical Certificate to their respective Form Teacher when they return to school after their medical leave. For Covid-19 related absences, students may submit a parent letter supported with an image of the positive ART test for up to 2 days of absences.
