SCHEDULE OF WEIGHTED ASSESSMENT 3 (WA 3) FOR SECONDARY TWO IN TERM 3

To nurture our students to be lifelong learners and building on the efforts to move away from an over-emphasis on academic results, MOE has adjusted school-based assessment (SBA) structures so that our students can experience more joy and develop stronger intrinsic motivation in learning.

In accordance with MOE guidelines, the school has allocated the percentage of each term's weighted assessment as shown in the table below. These weighted assessments (WA) count towards the final grade for each subject.

Please note that:

- there is no weighted assessment in Term 4 as the End of Year (EOY) Examination will begin in Term 4 Week 3;
- there is 1 weighted assessment per subject per term (except Term 4) and the format of the weighted assessment differs for each subject (refer to the overleaf for details).

For Design & Technology (D&T) and Food and Consumer Education (FCE) subjects only

Please note that:

- D&T and FCE subjects are modular subjects taken for one semester only. There will be **two** WA assessments conducted in Term 3;
- EOY examination for Art, D&T and FCE subjects will be conducted in Terms 3 and 4 during lesson time (refer to the overleaf for details).

Secondary 2 Normal (Academic)/ Normal (Technical) Subject-based Banding (SBB) mid-year inserts for English Language, Mother Tongue Languages, Mathematics and Science will be identified based on weighted assessment results and school-based holistic considerations.

Students who are certified medically unfit to take the Weighted Assessments will be recorded as "absent with valid reason". They must submit the original copy of the Medical Certificate from authorised medical practitioners to their respective Form Teacher when they return to school after their medical leave.
