When will streaming commence?	<p>Subject Allocation will start after the End of Year examination.</p> <p>Information will be provided nearer the date through Parents Gateway.</p> <p><b>For questions related to Sec 2 streaming, please see the slides attached.</b></p>
What is the criteria for students to take Higher Chinese at Sec 3?	<p>To be eligible to offer Higher Chinese (HCL), students should demonstrate (1) aptitude in the language and (2) a positive attitude towards learning at Sec 2.</p> <p>Eligibility also takes into consideration the subject teacher's recommendation based on observation and assessment of the students' learning in their daily work.</p>
Are you informing the parents if one of their classmate is C+?	If one of the classmates is covid-positive, the school will follow MOH's Healthcare Protocol to manage the positive case. If the covid-positive student is well (mild or no flu like symptoms), the school will advise the student to book an appointment at the Combined Test Centre (CTCs) and Quick Test Centre (QTCs) to do a supervised self administered ART test. The positive case will be updated in MOH's records. This will facilitate the issuance of Health Risk Notice (HRN) to close contacts for self monitoring.
During break time / recess, is there a person in charge of checking the students while they mask-off, to ensure no interaction and that they wear their mask after they are done eating.	Teachers have walkabout duties in the school however it might not coincide with all recess break times. Students are reminded frequently to wear their masks properly to be socially responsible to people around them and for themselves.

<p>Can the school allocate storage for students to leave books in class please?</p>	<p>Students are encouraged to bring their studying materials home to use for their daily assignments and revision for tests and examinations. Students are also reminded to pack their bags on a daily basis and encouraged to communicate with teachers for information on materials to be brought to school to lighten their carrying load.</p>
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
