MODES OF WEIGHTED ASSESSMENT

Scheduled on one day

Date Specific Written Test

Scheduled over a period of time

- Ongoing Project-based Assessments
- Coursework Assessments



Date Specific Weighted Assessment

- No RETEST will be conducted.
- Absence from school <u>must be covered by a Medical Certificate</u> or Official Reason.
- Absent without MC/ a valid reason will be given zero marks.
 Parent's letters will only be accepted in special circumstances such as bereavement of a family member or unforeseen accidents. Such circumstances will be considered on a case-bycase basis.
- For <u>Covid-19 related matters</u>, a parent's letter <u>with</u> an image of the positive ART test for up to 2 days of absence may be submitted



Project-based & Coursework Weighted Assessments

- Absence from school <u>must be covered by a Medical</u> <u>Certificate</u> or Official Reason
- Absence without MC/ a valid reason will be given zero marks. Parent's letters will only be accepted in special circumstances such as bereavement of a family member or unforeseen accidents. Such circumstances will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- For <u>Covid-19 related matters</u>, a parent's letter <u>with</u> an image of the positive ART test for up to 2 days of absence may be submitted



Absent with MC or Valid Reason for Project-based/ Coursework Weighted Assessments

 Subject teachers will make arrangements for you to complete your project-based/coursework assessments after curriculum time to ensure that you are able to complete your project/coursework.

 If you do not turn up for the session(s) without any valid reason, no further arrangements will be made.



Weighted Assessment Policy

• For any case of dishonesty, zero marks will be awarded and disciplinary action will be taken.

 Extra time will only be given to students who have been certified that they have special educational needs or medical conditions (applicable for date specific written tests).



Weighted Assessment Policy - Project-based Assessment

- 1. Do not plagiarise/copy from other sources this is considered as cheating. You should do your projects based on your own efforts. Disciplinary action will be taken for such cases of dishonesty.
- 1. For group/pair project WAs, be responsible and do your part of the work. No marks will be awarded if you are deemed to have not contributed to the project.



LATE-COMING POLICY

- a) <u>Latecomers (before 8.00 am)</u> will report as per normal procedure.
- a) Latecomers (at or after 8.00 am) will report as per normal procedure in GO and report to the assessment venue directly as the WA1 has started.
- a) No extra time will be given to late-comers without a valid reason.



EARLY DEPARTURE FROM SCHOOL& ABSENCE FROM CLASS

• If you are unwell and took the early departure form to leave school, you are to follow up on your absence from the weighted assessment(s) scheduled that day with an MC.

 If you know that you have a weighted assessment scheduled on the day, please ensure that you are in class during the respective subject periods.

* to follow Covid-19 protocol & submit parent letter with image of positive ART for Covid-19 related matters.




STUDENT WELL-BEING

- √Have a light breakfast before reporting for morning assembly so that you do not feel FAINT.




