RULES & REGULATIONS

Organisation

The AES 8-A-Side Football Challenge shall be played in accordance to:

- rules and regulations of the Singapore Primary School Sports Council Football Championships 2019
- adhere to the National School Games (NSG) Baseline Safety Standards
- According to the Laws/Rules established by The Federation Internationale de Football Association (FIFA)

The AES Football Challenge Cup 2019 is organised primarily for Primary 6 students.

However, you may include P5 students if you are unable to form an all P6 students team.

Format of Play

- Playing area will be the width of AES school field (50m (L) x 30m (B))
- One period of 10 minutes per match. (No Intervals)
- Teams should report to the court officials for their matches, 2 minutes before their match begins. Announcements will be made accordingly.
- Each team requires a minimum of 5 players on the pitch to start a match. Referees will start the match with no delays.
- Every Team Captain/Manager must sign off the result scorecard at the end of their match. (Compulsory)
- If a match at full-time ends in a draw, no extra-time will be given and it will be recorded as a draw during the preliminary rounds only

Competition Format

Preliminary Round – Round-robin format

~Top 2 winners from each group will qualify to 2nd round/quarter-final/Semi-final onwards.

(Subject to the number of participating teams)

~ 2nd round / Quarter-final/ Semi-final onwards – Knock-out stage

Preliminary Round – Round-robin format

~ 3 points for Win, 1 for Draw, 0 for Loss.

~ In the case of a tie in points in the preliminary round, it will be decided in the following order:

- i. Goal Difference
- ii. Most Goals Scored
- iii. Results between both teams
- iv. Sudden death penalty kicks

Substitution

- Rolling Substitution is allowed in each match.
- Substitution will be allowed at any time with prior approval and acknowledgement of the Referee.

Kick-off and Kick-in Rules

All kick-offs (ie. start of game, or after a goal is scored) shall be **indirect kicks**. The ball is allowed to go in any direction as long as it moves.

All kick-ins shall be **indirect kicks**. Opposing players must maintain a distance of 2 metres from the where the kick is being taken. The first ball kicked in must be ground ball played not higher than the knee of the kicker. If this rule is breached, the referee reserves the right to ask for the kick to be retaken or possession of the ball to be turned over.

Matters not provided for

All matters not provided for in the Rules & Regulations shall be dealt with by the Assumption English School's Organising Committee.

Reminder

Schools are reminded to be properly attired (ie. boots, shin pads and numbered jerseys) to this competition. Students are to bring their own water bottles.

Amendments

The AES Organising Committee shall have the right to delete, add or amend the rules and regulations laid down herein.
